

**INVER GROVE HEIGHTS CITY COUNCIL CANVASS MEETING
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2022 - 8:30 AM - 8150 BARBARA AVENUE**

A. CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Inver Grove Heights met in Special Meeting on Thursday, November 14, 2022, in city council chambers. Mayor Tom Bartholomew called the meeting to order at 8:30AM. Roll Call: Present were Council members Bartholomew, Dietrich, Murphy, Gliva and Piekarski Krech. Staff: City Administrator Wilson, City Clerk Kiernan, and Deputy City Clerk Malott.
