ACTION REQUESTED

The Council will be asked to discuss and seek consensus on key priorities for the 2023-24 time period.

BACKGROUND

During this retreat, the Council will gather with the City Administrator, Department Heads and Managers to identify, discuss and seek consensus on the key Council priorities for the two-year term between now and the next city election in 2024.

In preparation for the retreat, Councilmembers are asked to consider the following questions and come prepared to share your answers and consider those of your colleagues.

1. What are the 4 or 5 most common topics or issues that you hear about when out and about in the community and/or campaigning for office?
2. Based on the feedback you hear from residents, what does the City already do well? In what areas is there a need for improvement?
3. Is there a policy area, service or program that the City currently isn't very active in that you think we should be? Why? What role do you believe the City could or should play on this subject? What resources and/or expertise do we have to contribute?
4. What is one thing that the City - as a municipal government organization - should focus on 2023 to benefit our residents? (Outside of the everyday services such as responding to 911 calls, providing clean drinking water, maintaining streets and parks.)

The above questions do not reflect the totality of the anticipated discussion for the retreat, but they are intended to serve as a "jumping off point" for further discussion of Council priorities for 2023-24.
