SUBJECT: **Renovation Options for the VMCC's Brightside Room**

ACTION REQUESTED

The City Council and the Parks & Recreation Advisory Commission (PRAC) are asked to receive a presentation on the Brightside Room Renovation Project at the Veterans Memorial Community Center (VMCC), consider potential renovation options, and provide direction to staff on next steps.

BACKGROUND

The City's adopted Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) for 2025 includes a \$350,000 planned investment in the Brightside Room at the VMCC. There are several potential options for this space, each with their own cost, anticipated return on investment and target audience. At this time, two primary options are being given serious consideration.

The first option would be to develop an indoor playground designed to provide year-round recreational opportunities for children under the age of 10 and their families. This option would require a higher up-front capital investment but is expected to generate greater net annual revenue and offer a quicker return on investment.

The second option being explored would be to convert the Brightside Room into a multipurpose space, which could serve as a venue for recreation and fitness programs, community rentals, and youth use, including a potential half-court basketball area. While this option would be more versatile and have a lower capital cost, it is projected to generate less net revenue than the indoor playground and would take longer to achieve any return on investment.

To gather community input, staff hosted an open house at the VMCC on Wednesday, April 23, 2025, and also conducted a community survey promoted through social media, the City's website, the Insights Newsletter, and flyers distributed within the VMCC. The survey, which ran from mid-March through April 25, 2025, received 763 responses. Community members were asked to provide feedback on the two proposed options and were also invited to suggest alternative uses for the space. The attached survey results were presented to the PRAC at their regular meeting on May 14, 2025 and are shared as background information for this joint discussion.

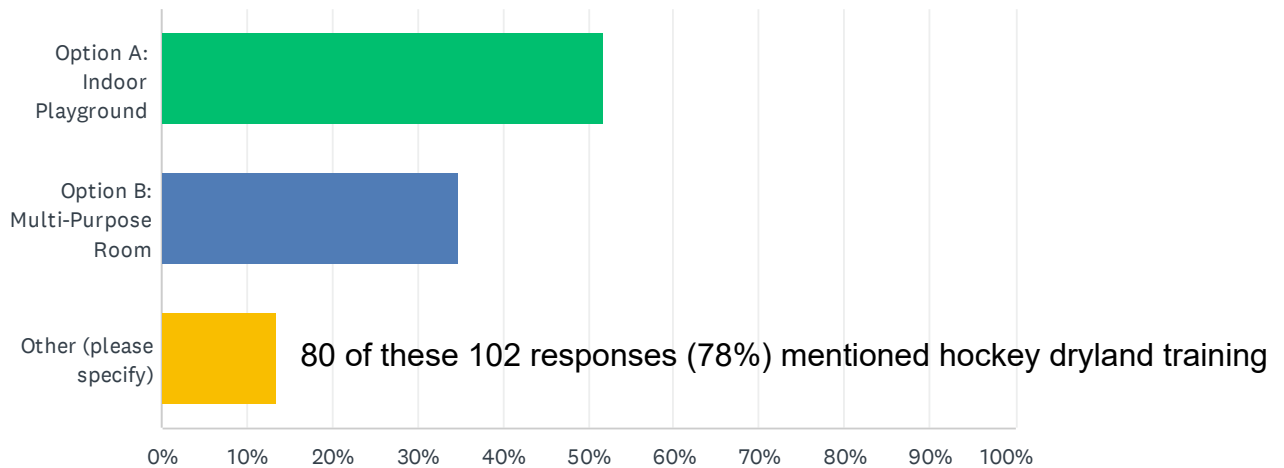

ACTION REQUESTED

The Council is asked to provide input on a new City Seal.

BACKGROUND

In May of 2024, a new Official Seal of the State of Minnesota was put in place; featuring a lake, a loon and the North Star.

The City of Inver Grove Heights also has an official seal, which is used on official City documents that get recorded, City-issued licenses, and certain ceremonial documents, such as proclamations. When applied to paper documents, the seal is raised, conveying that the document in hand is both official and an original.

The current City seal is modeled after the old state seal, with an image of a farmer, trees, a horse and rider, and a sun with rays, along with the French words "L'Etoile Du Nord", which translates to the Star of the North. Staff is proposing that the City seal be updated and that the new seal be independent of the state seal, so that should the State of Minnesota change its seal yet again in the future, it would have no impact on IGH. Similar work is underway to redesign our Police Department badges and patches, which were also based on the old state seal. In both cases, staff is proposing to incorporate images of the Rock Island Swing Bridge to make the seal, badges and patches uniquely IGH.

At its March 7, 2025 work session, the Council was presented with six design options for a new seal. Based on the Council's feedback at that meeting, two final options are being presented for Council review (see attached).

FISCAL IMPACT

The estimated cost to update the seal is \$350 for a new embosser and seal highlighter.

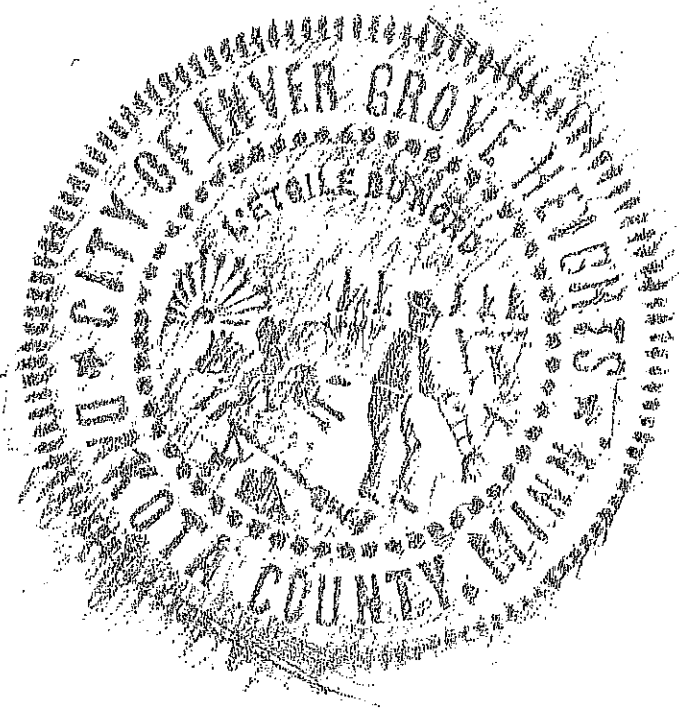

SUBJECT: Plans for 2025 State of the City Event

ACTION REQUESTED

The Council is asked to provide feedback and direction regarding the time, place and format of the 2025 State of the City event.

BACKGROUND

The City hosted a State of the City event each of the last two years, receiving positive feedback on both occasions. In order to get an early start on plans for this year's event, staff is seeking Council input on a several factors including date, time and location.

A key challenge in planning the two past events has been finding a location or venue for the event within the city limits. Factors to consider include:

- Number of people the venue can hold, while providing good sightlines and the ability to hear the presentation. (This is an open, public meeting, creating concerns when or if people have to be turned away.)
- Accessibility
- Availability of parking
- Cost to rent (if not City owned)
- Ability to serve, or have catered in, both food and beverages (previous years have included a cash bar for adult beverages; serving alcoholic beverages creates some limitations on where the event can be held and how to ensure no city funds are paying for alcohol)
- Site control / predictability (outdoor sites require a rain location for back-up, accommodations for wind or ambient noise, etc.)
- A/V resources
- Setting or atmosphere created by the location
- Potential for the perception of favoritism or conflict of interest if held at a local business

As for the date of the event, the last two events have been held in late November. This corresponds with a "year in review" feel to the event. Some other cities traditionally hold their State of the City event between January and May and use it more as a preview of the year ahead. If the City wants to hold the State of the City at a consistent time each year, it is important to factor in the election cycle. In even-numbered years, staff advises against holding the State of the City from the start of the candidate filing period through the General Election so it is not perceived as being a campaign advantage for incumbents running for reelection. If the Council were to consider holding the event earlier in the year, it would be important to not have it so early in an odd-numbered year that any

newly elected Mayor hasn't had time to get settled in or the full Council hasn't had time to hold a goal-setting session.

Lastly, is the time of day - and its connection to the feel of the event and the logistics and cost of food to be served. The last two events have been scheduled for a late afternoon / early evening "happy hour" time on a weekday, where people reasonably expect some food and drink, but not a full meal - which would be more costly and require a setting large enough to seat everyone around a table. This has also given the event more of a formal and adults-only feeling, whereas if the Council wanted to have a more family-friendly event it might be scheduled on a Saturday or Sunday afternoon at a park or the community center.

Members of the Council are asked to weigh the above considerations and come prepared to discuss their preferences for the 2025 State of the City event. Should it be held at the golf course again, which is city-owned and allows for the serving of adult beverages, but holds a relatively small crowd? Should we try using City Hall or the Community Center, which hold more people but may have more of a "city meeting" feel? Is there a local business that might work?
